#### ENGR. S.N.H. MASHHADI PRESIDENT PAKISTAN ENGINEERING CONGRESS

Born in October, 1931 at Ferozepur (undivided India), Engr. S.N.H. Mashhadi, President of the Pakistan Engineering Congress graduated first as a Mechanical Engineer in 1953 from the Punjab College of Engineering and Technology, Lahore and thereafter earned a degree in Civil Engineering in the following year i.e 1954.

He started his career with the Punjab Irrigation and Power Department in 1955. That was the crucial time when India had arbitrarily stopped irrigation supplies to the canals in Pakistan as Headworks of these canals were left on the Indian side. The Irrigation Department under these circumstances was seriously seized with the design and remodelling of the irrigation network to save the fertile-lands of south-eastern Punjab from turning barren. His first posting in the I&P Department was as O.S.D. Water Treaty Implementation Organization and was soon included in the group of engineers charged with the challenging design and remodelling works of irrigation system aimed at solving the imminent traumatic and catastrophic situation. His dedicated application to the assigned jobs, was duly rewarded by his accelerated promotion in 1962. In 1964 he was transferred to WAPDA, where he rendered desired services in the design, contact administration and construction supervision of Taunsa-Panjnad Link to the entire satisfaction of his seniors. Taunsa Panjnad Link channel was a major component of the Indus Basin Project. Engr. S.S. Kirmani, Chief Engineer, Indus Basin Project issued an appreciation letter for the services and contribution of Engr. Mashhadi on this Project.

After leaving government service, he joined Noon Qayyoom & Co., a Civil Engineering Consultancy Firm in 1973 to 1974. Soon after he was taken as a Partner of another Consultancy Firm, Engineering and Technical Consultants. Not satisfied with the state of affairs obtaining there, he launched his own Firm in the name and style of "National Development Consultants (Regd.)" in 1977 of which he is the Managing Partner.

Engr. Mashhadi has been instrumental in enhancing the image of the Engineering Congress. For over 20 years he has been organizing Engineering Congress set up in the capacity of an Executive Council Member, Business Manager, twice as Secretary, and as Vice-President. In almost every session he took upon himself the voluntary role of acting as Convener Library and Publication Committee and Building and Fund Raising Committee. He always came up with all the resources at his command, both financial and secretariat of his Firm.

His services to Engineering Community are by no means insignificant. He has contributed about two dozen technical papers in the Pakistan Engineering Congress Proceedings, Engineering News Journal and other local and international journals.

His services in the Civil Engineering Consultancy field were acknowledged by the Association of Consulting Engineers Pakistan (ACEP) when he was elected unopposed as the President of this Organization in the year 2000 for a period of three years.


It is in consideration of his professional/ technical achievements that the Marquis Who's Who Publications U.S.A. published his biography in their fifth edition for the year 2000-2001.


His services were very aptly acknowledged by the Congress Members when they elected him as President, Pakistan Engineering Congress for 68th Session representing the Consultants turn.
