

Information Regarding Membership of Pakistan Engineering Congress

1. Clause (3) of Memorandum of Association Articles & Bye-Laws of Pakistan Engineering Congress stipulates as under about the Qualification required for the Membership of the Congress:
 - a) To be eligible for Membership of the Congress a person shall have passed a degree examination in engineering as laid down by Pakistan Engineering Council or shall have attained such standing in engineering, science or architecture and/or other allied science so as to qualify him, in the opinion of the Executive Council, for the distinction of Membership.
 - b) The President of Pakistan and the high dignitaries whose appointment brings them in close relationship with engineering for the period of their tenure of office, may, with their prior consent, be elected Honorary Members of the Congress as prescribed by the Bye-Laws.
 - c) Honorary Life Members may be selected as prescribed in the Bye-Laws on account of their eminence in engineering or their special services rendered in the interest of the Congress.
2. Application for the Membership of the Congress is to be submitted to Secretary Pakistan Engineering Congress in the enclosed application form. (Photocopy of the form can also be used).

Application form is to be completed and sent alongwith attested copy of Bsc Engineering Degree, copy of PEC Registration Certificate, a copy of CNIC and two passport size photographs.

It is to be decided by the applicant for how many years the Membership of the Congress is desired. Payment is to be made in Cash or through an A/c Payee, Demand Draft payable at Lahore. Applications received will be submitted to Executive Council for approval after which a certificate of Membership will be issued.
